e-Clearance Slip

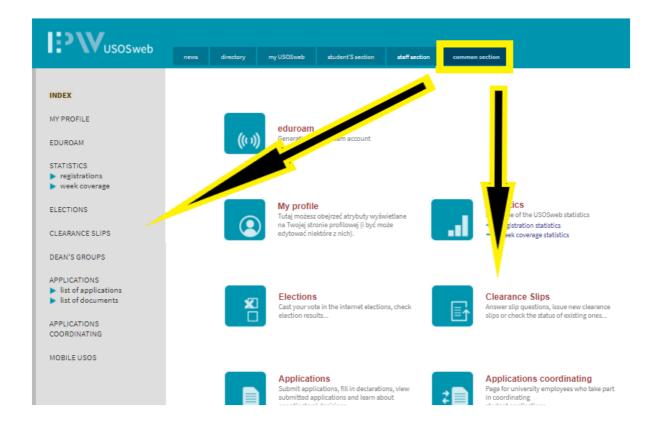
Starting from January 15, 2021, we are introducing at our Faculty Electronic Clearance Slip.

The settlement of the Clearance Slip by the Dean's Office, the Diploma Institute, the Administration of the Student's Dormitory, the Faculty Library and the Main Library will be done remotely in USOSweb.

From January 15, 2021 students who submit their documents for the diploma examination will have opened e-Clearance Slips in the USOSweb system by the employees of the Dean's Office. Former students and graduates who have not yet settled the Clearance Slip are asked to send an e-mail to the Dean's Office (from the address in the WUT domain) with a request to start the e-Clearance Slip in USOSweb. 1. Selection of the Clearance Slips module

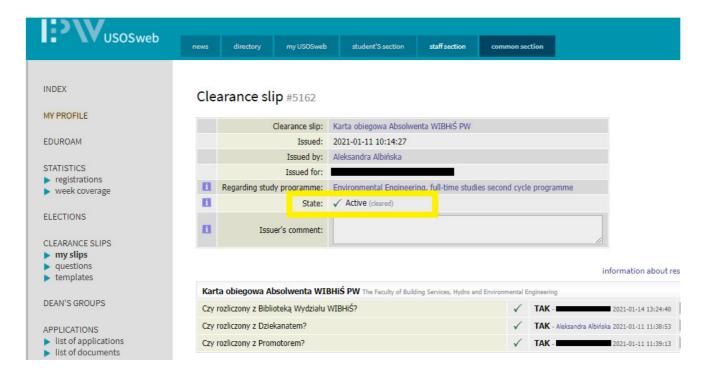
After logging in to USOSweb (https://usosweb.usos.pw.edu.pl) select the COMMON SECTION tab, and then CLEARANCE SLIPS.



- 2. Status of e-Clearance Slip: When is a graduate or former student settled with the university? Active e-Clearance Slip can get 4 states:
 - cleared,
 - rejected,
 - pending,
 - ambiguous.

CLEARED:

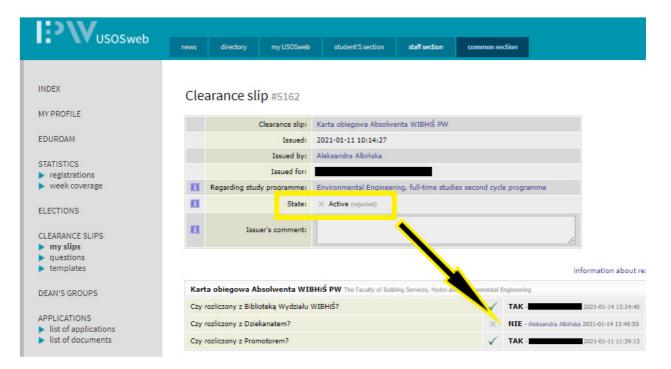
A graduate or a former student is settled with the university only when the status of his e-Clearance Slip is CLEARED, which means that all questions were answered YES. Before collecting documents (e.g. diploma) from the WUT Student Register Department, make sure that your e-Clearance Slip has received status CLEARED.



REJECTED:

If the answer to at least one question is NO, the e-Clearance Slip receives the REJECTED status.

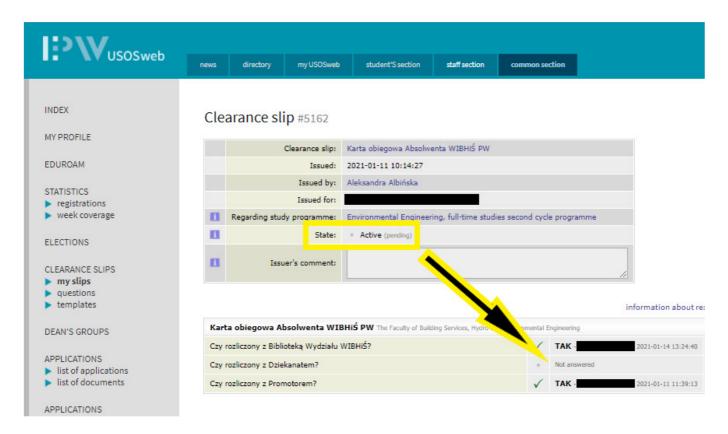
The answer NO means that the person for whom the e-Clearance Slip was issued did not settle all obligations towards the university. After completing the missing obligations, in order to update the status of the e-Clearance Slip (change the answer), inform the employee who gave a negative answer about this fact (after clicking on the e-Clearance Slip, its details will be displayed, including the employee's data).



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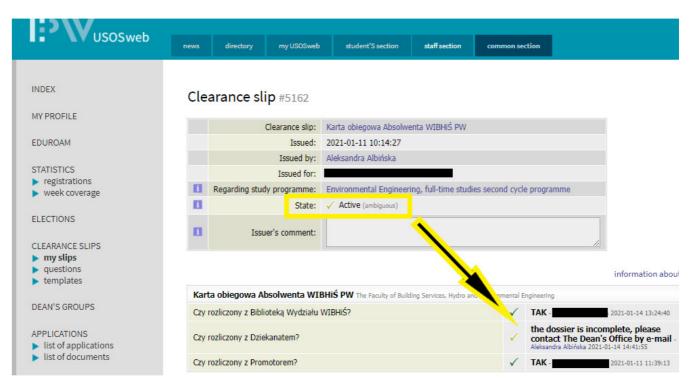
PENDING:

If at least one question has not been answered yet and the remaining questions have been answered YES the e-Clearance Slip gets the PENDING status.



AMBIGUOUS:

If the answer to at least one question is other than YES or NO, the e-Clearance Slip gets the status AMBIGUOUS. This means that the employee responsible for the settlement posted a comment - information for the settled person.



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
